I, do hereby acknowledge and realize there is no guarantee that players will remain on the same team, or with the same coach from year to year. Rules to prior year assignments may not apply. Teams will be assigned in a manner decided by the Football Director and Head Coaches prior to the beginning of season play. I, do hereby acknowledge and realize that the participation of the above child in the activities of Cahaba Valley Football does involve some risk of bodily harm. I hereby authorize Cahaba Valley Football, its agents, servants, and employees to provide such emergency medical service to the child above, as reasonably appears to be necessary if bodily injury occurs to said child. In consideration of allowing the above child to participate in the activities of Cahaba Valley Football, I hereby release Cahaba Valley Football, its agents, servants and employees from any and all claims, demands or suits which may be made against Cahaba Valley Football, its agents, servants and employees arising out of bodily injury to the above child or arising out of the provision of emergency medical care to the above child. I further agree, in consideration of the above child or indemnify and hold harmless Cahaba Valley Football, its agents, servants and employees from any and all claims, demands, and suits which may occur as a result of bodily injury to the above child.

Parent/Guardian Agreement

The purpose of The Cahaba Valley Youth Football League is to equip and train our boys in the skills and knowledge of football in a competitive environment. We will accomplish this through Godly leadership and quality coaching to better prepare them for Jr. High and High School. Our program is bigger than any one player, coach or spectator. As a Cahaba Valley Lion spectator, we require the following: We expect our program to create a positive and Christian environment as we compete against other youth programs. All parties involved with our program should behave in a way that is honoring to God. Encourage members of both teams.

- Keep all comments positive.
- Only players and coaches are allowed on the field, no exceptions.
- Leave the coaching to the coaches. If you have suggestions or would like to coach next year's team, please volunteer so you can attend the mandatory coaching clinics, pass the background check, sign the coaches contract and pass the coaches written test.
- Criticizing the officials, coaches, opponents or fans will not be tolerated at all. Same goes for abusive language or cursing. This is youth sports, everyone makes mistakes.
- Be supportive, creating unnecessary drama or stirring controversy is grounds for dismissal from the program.
- Any conflicts or complaints should be handled in a Biblical manner. First, go to the coach with whom you have a difference and resolve. If it does not get resolved, go to the coach again with a witness. If it still does not get resolved, contact the CVL Board President.

Policy Enforcement

- The CVL Board President will call the individual who has been accused of the violation. If it is clear the violation has occurred, the phone call will serve as a warning. All board members will be advised of the incident.
- If a second violation occurs during the same season, a phone call will be made to confirm the violation and all board members will be advised. If it is clear the violation has occurred, the board reserves the right to ask the individual not to return for the remainder of the events for that season. Individuals that continue will be asked to leave the fields and the player will be removed from the game until the spectator has left.
- Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the president and board may be enforced.
- It is the intention of the Cahaba Valley Board to communicate to all participants in our program a code of conduct to be adhered to at all games, practices and activities. The coaches, players and cheerleaders are allowed to participate in our program with the consent of the CVFC board. The board reserves the right to refuse participation of any individual who consecutively violates our code of conduct.

It is the board's desire to never have to enforce the above code of conduct. Please be considerate and thoughtful as you attend all CVFC events. We believe we have a higher calling and want all of our people to enjoy youth football and cheerleading.

Cahaba Valley Lion Player Agreement

- I agree to abide by the Cahaba Valley Youth Football Players Conduct Code as well as to the authority given all authorized coaches in the program. Failure to follow the code or coaches instruction will be deemed grounds for disciplinary action and or dismissal from the team.
- I will respect all coaches at all time, calling them Coach or Mr. Last Name.
- I will say Yes Ma'am, No Ma'am, Yes Sir and No Sir when speaking to an adult.
- I will respect and obey my parents/guardians and teachers at all times.
- I will respect referees and opponent players and coaches at all times.
- I will have good sportsmanship as my number one priority in all games and practices.
- If I have an unsportsmanlike event, it can result in my immediate removal from game and one game suspension. If I have an unsportsmanlike event that is a result of poor interaction with a referee, it can result in my season long suspension.
- I will not use profanity or derogatory language.
- I will encourage my teammates in a positive way, regardless of circumstances.
- I will attend all scheduled practices and games. If unable to do so, I will contact my head coach beforehand. If I have an unexcused absence, it can result in loss of game playing time.
